Lara has developed trafficking policies, leads statewide awareness initiatives, and co-founded programs focused on prevention, survivor support, and labor trafficking education.
- For the past 10 years, Lara has raised human trafficking awareness across Northwest Ohio through healthcare and community outreach. She developed Firelands Health's human trafficking policy, chairs the Ohio Attorney General's HTI Public Awareness Subcommittee, and leads several organizations focused on prevention, education, and survivor support.
- Lara is committed to providing healthcare professionals with evidence-based, survivor- and trauma-informed education. She also co-founded the BGSU Labor Trafficking Education and Research Initiative to advance awareness and prevention efforts.
