MEMBERSHIP

Annual Membership Dues Policy:
The Ohio BWC Safety Council Rebate Program requires annual enrollment in a local safety council by July 31 of that fiscal year.

Dues Structure for Fiscal Year 27 (July 1, 2026 through June 30, 2027)

- 25 employees or less \$120
- 26 – 50 employees \$160
- 51 – 100 employees \$200
- 101 – 500 employees \$280
- 501 – 1000 employees \$360
- 1001 – 3000 employees \$480
